Registration: Each candidate is required to complete an Application for Registration Form, which is adjudicated by a panel of Selectors for selection to the course.

Eligibility: Ideal candidates include newly graduated mechanical engineers and technicians, beltsman supervisors, and student engineers. Also engineers and supervisors who want to know more about splicing quality control and reasons for splice failures.

Entrance criteria: This course has been developed to encourage supervisors and engineers in the conveyor industry that have no practical splicing experience to have a good understanding of correct splicing methods.

Requirements: Candidates will require writing equipment for taking notes

Language: Lectures and the self-assessment will be conducted in English, however the lecturer is also fluent in Afrikaans.

Programme: The Splicing course is run over three consecutive days.

Day 1	Registration and lectures
Day 2	Practical
Day 3	Practical

CPD credits: This course is registered with ECSA for Continuous Professional Development credits. 3 credits may be claimed for attendance.

Number of candidates: A minimum of 12 candidates is required for each course. A maximum limit of 16 candidates per course has been set to ensure that the syllabus is adequately covered within the time constraints.

Date of courses: 2016. 1-3 March

Course Outcome: All candidates will come away with a firm knowledge of correct splicing methods, and of the relevant National Standards for belt splicing. Candidates will have a good understanding of probable causes of belt splice failures.

Successful candidates will have their names recorded on the CMA website for posterity.
